
James 2:26

Biblical Works

Biblical works is - If we say we believe and put our trust in Jesus, Our actions will reveal that we do. Works should be a byproduct of your faith in Jesus. Your trust in him should call you to put one foot forward in the midst of the situations you are believing him to bring his sovereign hand in; or you should be doing whatever the spirit is nudging you to do in the midst of unforeseeable trials.

The Misconception of this verse

Most People believe you must go physically labor to activate their faith or get Jesus to act on their behalf when that is not so. What does clocking into a job or going to work hard (outside of God's will for you) have to do with Jesus + your faith? That literally makes no sense, We have to remember that we are partnering with God not playing God - We're not to be moving the chess pieces here.

A better translation of this verse would be "Faith without Good deeds is dead" James 2:26 (NLT). I think it would also be best to read the whole James 2 for better revelation and what the Lord was linking 'works' or "good deeds" to.

Why We Need Good deeds to Sustain faith?




Activate deeds in your every step of Faith
